Director Resignation

Patterson— June 7, 2019 — Today at a special board meeting, the Del Puerto Health Care District accepted the resignation of Sheree Lustgarten from the District’s Board of Directors. Ms. Lustgarten ran unopposed in the November 2018 election for a four-year term ending in December 2022. The District thanked her for her service.

The District has 60 days to advertise, accept applications, interview candidates, and appoint a replacement Director. Since the seat is being vacated in the first half of the term of office and more than 130 days before the next District general election the person appointed to fill the vacancy shall hold office until the November 2020 election. The Board is accepting letters of interest from District residents interested in appointment to the Board and more information is available at www.dphealth.org.
